**BREED NOTES: Young horses (thru-3 yrs) shall be shown in-hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Bridles are mandatory on 2 yr. olds and older. Young horses judged 60% movement, 30% conf., 10% gen. impressions. Mature horses (4 years and older) judged 50% movement, 40% conf., 10% gen. imp. Class 20 must be pre-entered; horses and owners must be members of AHS. Class 21 entered under dam, one entry fee per group. Class 22 entered under sire, one entry fee per group. Please note new rule for 2007: (DR 205.3) "Each horse entered in a group class must have an individual entry form completed and on file with the competition secretary, even if the horse is not competing in other classes. USEF fees and at least a USEF HID must be submitted for each horse in a group entry." No fees for championships. Under saddle classes to be shown at w-t-c both ways.**

## PERFORMANCE DIVISION NOTES:

**The Sporting Horse Amateur Challenge -Training and First Level** - Open to amateur riders that have never competed above Intermediate I-1. Horse and rider combination to enter two tests on Saturday and one test on Sunday (either Training or First Level). The lowest score will be dropped and the remaining scores averaged to determine a winner at Training and a winner at First Level. **Second-Third-Fourth & PSG/I-1 Level** - Open to amateur riders that have never competed above I-1. Second Level Riders must enter classes 44 & 60, Third Level Riders must enter 46 & 65, Fourth Level Riders must enter 48 & 69, PSG/I-1 Riders must enter 49(may select PSG or I-1) & 73. The two scores will be averaged to determine the winner at Second, Third, Fourth, & PSG/I-1 levels.

**SHAC AMATEURS: USEF AA status not required, but by entering the SHAC, competitors declare themselves as Amateurs according to USEF GR 808; Juniors/Young Riders may also compete in the SHAC.**

All SHAC winners will receive a prize and participate in an awards ceremony. 3 or 4 riders of any level may join up for a team competition with the three best averages used to determine the winning teams. There is no extra fee for the team competition.

Please indicate on the entry form whether you are entering SHAC or BLM-Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Qualifier 2009 or USDF/GAIG-Q Greater American Insurance Group Qualifier 2009 classes; for USDF/GAIG-Q qualifiers ONLY add \$10 to class fee as indicated on entry form. For Test of Choice (TOC) please indicate which test you are riding. There will be \$500 prize money awarded to the winners of classes 73 - The Prix St. George Challenge, class 103 - Grand Prix TOC and 102 - Intermediate 1 and \$100 to high score winners on Friday. Classes 106 & 107 are USEF/Markel Young Horse Qualifying classes – see [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org) for full details.

- All entries must be signed and accompanied by: payment, coggins test dated July 10, 2008 or later, copies of all registrations and membership cards, and an emergency contact and phone number on the stabling portion of the entry.
- Prize money paid by check at the show.

**NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.** No refunds for any reason after closing date, including cancellation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency. Refunds before closing date are less office fee. On-line entries refunded before closing date are paid by check less office fee and on-line entry fee. No refunds after closing date.

**STABLING:** Large permanent box stalls with doors available: initial bedding provided. Riders must provide an emergency contact and phone number on the stabling portion of the entry.  
\$100 per stall/per week-end (Thursday 7/9 noon thru Sunday 7/12 7pm).-\$55 per stall per day

Early arrivals need prior approval. Pursuant to USEF rule 1211.5 each barn has one sharps container per 50 horses. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. In reference to GR 301.5 minors must have a valid driver's license issued by their state of residence in order to operate a motorized vehicle on competition grounds.
