AWARDS: Trophy & 6 ribbons per class. High Score Awards (Finals & MFS classes excluded): Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth, Combined FEI, AA, Jr/YR & Over-All.

Great American/USDF Region 1 Championships: Special awards for Champion and Reserve Champion, ribbons through 8th place from USDF. Prize Money – divided equally for each class with 60% of amount per class to the Champion and 40% to the Reserve Champion. The amount of the prize money to be awarded to each Champion and Reserve Champion in all levels of the 2010 Championship will be announced in February, 2010. Prize Money for the GAIG/USDF Regional Championships will be paid direct by the USDF office to the recorded horse owner within 30 days of the end of the event. Please note: **Riders placing in Great American/USDF Regional Championship classes must be present, mounted and in full riding attire for awards ceremonies. Failure, without prior permission of the competition manager, to be present and properly attired, will eliminate the official score and placing and the next highest score will move up in placing. Competitors may decline to participate in the victory round for safety reasons. Requests to be excused from the awards ceremony must occur ONE HOUR before the scheduled ceremony, except in the case of an emergency. The requests must be made to the Awards Coordinator who must confer with the USDF Representative, the Competition Manager, and the Technical Delegate.**

(*no processing fees*) Telephone, Fax entries are NOT ACCEPTED AT ANY TIME. Full Payment must accompany ALL entries – credit cards ONLY with online entries, no credit cards accepted at show. If allowed, late entries must use Online Entry System.

STABLING: \$160 noon Wednesday thru Sunday night or any portion, includes 1 bale initial bedding. Extra bedding pre-orders should be made with entry – paid at check-in. Permanent stalls w/doors on grounds. **Tack Stalls** – same fee, no bedding, *may be LIMITED*. Extra nights - \$40/night/stall. Use ONE Group Name for stable-with requests! Stallion owners must buy tack stall 'buffer'. Stabling Information & Assignments will be posted on show website. **NON-COMPETES** – pay stabling and non-compete fee, submit completed entry form and negative coggins. Non-competes will be wait-listed until all performance entries are accepted, if late entries are allowed, no late fee on non-competes.

ARENAS: Finals – 2 indoor rings (separate buildings) with composite footing, grandstand seating in coliseum, bleacher seating at East Building, 1 outdoor may be used with crushed granite, all-weather footing, bleacher seating. **Open Classes** – 4-5 outdoor rings with crushed granite, all-weather footing. Warm-Up – one covered (only for Finals), one small indoor (only for Finals), 2 large outdoor, 2 small outdoor. Similar footing to performance arenas. Lungeing pens and grass areas available. No lungeing in any warm-up arenas.

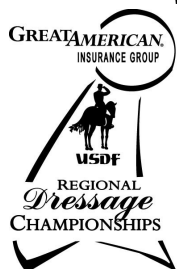
