CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: Indicate Division on entry form. Classes will be split as entries warrant. Management reserves the right to split or combine classes, add or substitute judges, or change ride times with appropriate notice. **Freestyle:** Specify level of ride; enclose copy of qualifying test. **GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes:** concurrent with class with addl. fee of \$10. Indicate Q on entry. **Opportunity Classes** are intended for entry level riders; cross entry w/Intro is allowed. Horses and riders participating only in Opportunity Classes are exempt from USEF and USDF membership/non-member fees, drug fee and Horse Identification (HID) requirements. If horse or rider does have HID or membership numbers, they must be listed on the entry form.

On-line Entry with Credit Card Payment available at ESS site. \$10 processing fee;

"Perfect Entry Refund" does not apply. **Late Entries \$40, if accepted, ONLY on-line.**

Class Fees: Intro & Eq. \$25 Training-First, In-Hand: \$30 Second -Third-Fourth: \$35
FEI, Freestyles, Quadrille & Pas de Deux \$40. GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes Add \$10.

Entry must include (*Nos. 1 thru 4 do not apply to Opportunity Classes, Intro., Quad, Pas de Deux*):

- 1) Copy of current USEF membership card(s) for owner, rider, trainer, and coach (indicating Amateur status for Amateur classes) or non-member fee(s).
- 2) Copy of rider's & owner's USDF membership or non-member ID number & fee.
- 3) Copy of horse's USDF HID or Lifetime Number.
- 4) Copy of USEF & USDF registrations for Qualifying classes.
Rider and owner must be USEF members for Qualifying classes
- 5) Copy of Current Negative Coggins (horse's name must be same as on entry form).
- 6) \$20 Office Fee (includes \$1 admission). \$10 refund for hard-copy entry on time & complete.
- 7) \$20 per day jump-out/grounds fee for horses showing from trailer.

Non-entered horses on the grounds only with prior arrangement and \$50 schooling fee.

Post Entries accepted, if schedule permits, w/ post entry fee of \$10 per class.

Late entry \$40 if accepted (on-line only). Change of horse and/or rider after closing \$25.

Draw checks to Northern Lights Dressage Shows (NLDS); mail entries to Secretary.

REFUNDS: Full refund, less office fee, prior to closing. Except for USDF/USEF fees, no refund after closing date through end of show for any reason, including acts of god.

AWARDS: Trophy, ribbons to sixth place.

STABLING: Permanent 10x10 stalls with doors, on show grounds. \$110 duration of 3-day show (Thurs. PM thru Sunday PM). \$45 per night (6pm-6pm) or portion thereof. Original bedding (1 bag) provided. Additional shavings may be ordered on entry form at \$8 per bag, and will be available during the show while supplies last. Tack stalls same fee, based on availability (no bedding). Stabling will be available **AFTER 3 PM** the day before the show.

DIRECTIONS: From I-94, North on CR 15 (Manning Ave.) to MN Hwy 5, turn right. From the South, I-35E to I-494 East, which becomes I-694 North. Exit at State Hwy 5, go East to grounds.
