CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: Indicate Division on entry form. Classes will be split as entries warrant. Management reserves the right to split or combine classes, add or substitute judges, or change ride times with appropriate notice. **Freestyle:** Specify level; enclose copy of qualifying test. **Opportunity Classes** If horse or rider has HID or membership numbers, they must be listed. **GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes:** Up to two rides each level per day (by using Test of Choice class). Additional fee of \$10 per ride. Indicate qualifying ride on entry; enclose copy of horse's USEF & USDF registrations

Class Fees: Intro. \$30. Training, 1st, Para: \$35. 2nd-3rd-4th, USEF TOC, Quadrille and Pas de Deux, \$40. FEI, FEI TOC and Freestyles \$45. Materiale \$40. Qualifying add \$10.

Entry must include (*Nos. 1 thru 4 do not apply to Opportunity Classes, Intro, Quad., Pas deDeux*):

- 1) Copy of current USEF membership card(s) for owner, rider, trainer, and coach (indicating Amateur status for riders in Adult Amateur classes) or Show Pass fee(s).
- 2) Copy of rider's & owner's USDF membership or non-member ID number & fee.
- 3) Copy of horse's USDF HID or Lifetime Number.
- 4) Copy of USEF & USDF registrations for Qualifying classes.
Rider and owner must be USEF members for Qualifying classes
- 5) Copy of Current Negative Coggins (horse's name must be same as on entry form). Per USEF Rule 845, be prepared to show proof of vaccination for Flu/Rhino in past 6 months.
- 6) \$25 Office Fee (includes \$1 admission).
- 7) \$20 per day jump-out/grounds fee for horses showing from trailer.

Non-entered horses on the grounds **only** with prior arrangement, \$50 schooling fee & stabling.

Post Entries accepted, if schedule permits, w/ post entry fee of \$10 per class.

Late Entry \$40 (on-line only). Changes made after closing date \$25.

Draw checks to Northern Lights Dressage Shows (NLDS); mail entries to Eq. Sec. Services.

REFUNDS: Full refund, less office fee, prior to closing. Except for USDF/USEF fees, no refund after closing date through end of show for any reason, including acts of god.

AWARDS: Trophy, ribbons to sixth place. Division High Score Awards.

STABLING: Permanent 10x10 stalls with doors, on show grounds. \$90 duration of show (Friday PM thru Sunday PM). \$45 per night (6pm-6pm) or portion thereof. Original bedding (1 bag) provided. Additional may be ordered on entry form at \$8 per bag, available during the show while supplies last. Tack stalls at same price, based on availability (no bedding). **Stabling will be available after 2 PM, schooling areas after 3PM the day before the show;** Please plan your arrival accordingly.

DIRECTIONS: From I-94, North on CR 15 (Manning Ave.) to Old MN Hwy 5, turn right. From I-694 exit at Old MN Hwy 5, go East. Fairgrounds are one mile east of Lake Elmo on south side of Hwy.
